The Health, Safety & Environmental (HSE) Coordination Manager, will be reporting to the Planning, Design and Permitting Director.

Our new colleague in this position, will be responsible to provide key advice to Hellinikon Project in respect of construction health, safety and environmental risk management matters and to ensure compliance of the design with health, safety and environmental regulations in all applicable areas by implementing a proper HSE management system.

In detail, the HSE Coordination Manager will be responsible for the following aspects of the Hellinikon Project:

Planning & Management: The HSE Coordination Manager shall be responsible for the development
and administration of Hellinikon Project HSE Policy and HSE Management System standards, covering
the pre-construction and construction stage. He or she will coordinate matters relating to health,
safety and environmental requirements so that the Project can be carried out without risks to health
and safety for all involved. Additionally, our new colleague will monitor the effective implementation
of the relevant System procedures and provide for their continuous update, always aligned with any



changes in relevant legislation. This also entails the training of all company personnel, so that everyone will clearly understand the Company HSE system procedures

- Design Assessment: In this role, our new colleague has to ensure that the Project design always complies with the applicable HSE requirements of the regulations. He or she must prepare a health and safety file for every individual project and ensure it is appropriately reviewed, updated and revised. Additionally, he or she shall also identify and collect the pre-construction relevant information and provide it in a convenient form to designers, project team, contractors and other parties as required. The HSE Coordination Manager also provides input in Design for its buildability, use, routine maintenance (including re-pointing, re-decorating or cleaning), repair & conduct HSE Risk assessment
- Construction Assessment: The HSE Coordination Manager assist/advises working teams by verifying
 the sufficiency of the construction phase plan to commence construction and the adequacy of the
 welfare provisions. He or she also prepares the health and safety file, reviews and updates relevant
 files until the end of construction. Finally, the job holder also concludes the HSE risk assessment of
 Construction Management plan
- Additional tasks: Participates in the Hellinikon Project permit process, leads the Value Engineering
 exercise when requested by Chief Planning Officer. Provides technical input in the Work Change
 procedure as required, audits Contractor's HSE systems, drives the accident / incident investigation
 etc
