The Senior Change Engineer will be reporting to the Risk & Change Manager.

Our new colleague in this position, will be responsible to provide technical expertise, to the Hellinikon Program, for the Change Management function. He or she shall support other Project and Program Controls functions & play a key role in the integration, analysis and monitoring the Hellinikon Program's Change data and in the preparation of all relevant Reports.

In detail, the Senior Change Engineer will be responsible for the following aspects of the Hellinikon Project:

- Change Management Framework: Provide support in the development, management and implementation of the Program's Change Management Plan, Policies and Procedures; the job holder will be responsible for the development, management and administration of the Risk Management Systems & act as a liaison with all Risk Management staff and consultants
- **Change Register:** Develop, manage, update, report and issue the Program's Change Register, by integrating the assigned Consultants', Project Managers' and Contractors' Project Risk Data. He or she will also prepare the data and deputy-chair all associated Change Management meetings



- Change Assurance: our new colleague in this position will also be responsible for the Assurance of all Change data submitted by the Consultants', Project Managers' and Contractors; adherence checking, and reporting against agreed Risk KPIs
- **Reporting:** Prepare and issue of Monthly/Quarterly/Annual Progress, as well as ad-hoc, Reports and Presentations to the management team & the Internal and External Stakeholders; he or she shall develop the templates and dashboards related to Risk data, conduct "what-if" studies, based on the Risk data and provide independent analyses, for proposed Program Revisions and Changes
- Integration: the job holder should also be alert in any changes/ variations that may influence the Program's outcomes. Will also support the development, management, update, reporting and issuing of the Integrated Program Master Schedule and Baseline and work together with the relevant teams
